Even today it is energetic and replete with activities, thanks to the Comune di Bagni di Lucca and groups such as AUSER (voluntary association) and Il Borgo degli Artisti (artists association and gallery). Here are just a few of the upcoming events:

At Il Borgo degli Artisti's gallery near Ponte a Serraglio bridge (northeast corner), don't miss the upcoming evening exhibitions (5 to 7.30 pm):

- painter Laura Ballini, *Oltre lo Sguardo* (1 to 8 July),
- photographer Cesare Giannetti (10 to 17 July),
- painter Gabriele Moschini (19 to 31 July).

These are always fun occasions to view the artworks but also to chat with the international citizens who gather inside and outside the gallery, over the cool waters of the Lima River.

At the nearby Casinò just across the river, a fun fashion show is planned for 3 July at 9 pm: **24 hours of Vintage: From morning chic to evening glam.**

From mid-July through August, a landscape drawing course is being offered at the Ninfa Hotel, taught by Deenagh Miller. The course is free; simply join the Il Borgo degli Artisti association to take part.

Coming up next month (4 to 17 August), visit the charming village of Montefegatesi, which will be hosting a collective exhibition of painting, sculptures, and poetry.
