Fourth Annual Grapevine Award

For writers under 40, a cash award and publication will be offered by the Associazione Culturale Grapevine for the best article (judged anonymously) suitable for publishing in *Grapevine*.

1. Submission by post or email (see page 3) before Nov. 30, 2014;
2. Length 400 to 800 words per article;
3. Must relate to Lucca, Pisa or Livorno (provinces) or their people;
4. Must be in English but can be a translation (if so, the translator can share in the award);
5. Submissions in Italian translated by *Grapevine*, €25 fee;
6. All worthy articles will be considered for publication;
7. Publication will be before December 2015;
8. Submissions will not be returned;
9. Members of judges' families may not apply.
